Drug and/or Alcohol Testing

1. _____ is prohibited from consuming any alcoholic beverages as a condition of visiting with the minor children.

_____ shall submit to random alcohol testing by the Probation Office of this Court. Failure to appear for testing shall be deemed a violation of this Order. Any evidence of alcohol use at any time shall be deemed a violation of this Order and no further visits will take place. The Probation Office will notify the other party that no further visits will occur as a result of said test result.

2. _____ is prohibited from consuming any alcoholic beverages within 24 hours prior to and during any visit with the minor child(ren).

_____ shall submit to random alcohol testing by the Probation Office of this Court. Failure to appear for testing shall be deemed a violation of this Order. Any evidence of alcohol use 24 hours prior to a visit shall be deemed a violation of this Order and no visit will take place. The Probation Office will notify the other party that the scheduled visit will not occur as a result of said test result. Any evidence of alcohol use during a visit will result in termination of the visit.

3. _____ is prohibited from using any illicit drugs as a condition of visiting with the minor child(ren).

_____ shall submit to drug testing by the Probation Office of this Court. All testing shall take place at the Court. Said drug testing shall be conducted randomly as determined by the Probation Office. The _____ will be notified by the Probation Office when to appear for said testing and he/she shall be required to appear. Failure to appear for testing shall be deemed a violation of this Order. If a positive test for illicit drugs takes place, it shall be deemed a violation of this Order and no further visits will take place. The Probation Office will notify the other party that no further visits will occur as a result of said test result.
